

### Outdoor rink program expands in Cardinal Creek

The Cardinal Creek Community Association (CCCA) is now operating a new outdoor ice rink at Valin - East Village Park, located in the Oakridge Gate / East Village subdivision, thanks to over \$4,700 in private sector sponsorships the CCCA has secured from local businesses. The CCCA continues to operate and maintain an outdoor rink at Cassia Park, in the Spring Ridge subdivision.

The CCCA is pleased to announce that **Ashcroft Homes**, **Richcraft Group of Companies**, **Orléans Boat World & Sports**, **BMR/Builders' Warehouse**, **Orléans Sign** and **The Flag Shop** (838 Bank Street) have come on board to support our rink operations for the Valin - East Village inaugural 2008-09 skating season. The new rink officially opened on January 3, 2009.

The CCCA also extends its thanks to the City of Ottawa Outdoor Rink Program and Councillor Bob Monette for city funding and in-kind support to ensure the expansion of our rink operations.

#### Rink Safety

For the enjoyment and safety of all rink users, we ask that you **please stay off the ice after dark** and during bad weather to minimize injury to yourself and damage to the ice surface, as well as to allow for regular scraping and flooding of the rink. We also STRONGLY recommend that all rink users wear a helmet when engaging in on-ice activities.

Coloured flags have been installed at both rinks to inform passers-by and users of rink conditions. Please keep off the ice surfaces when red flags are flying.

There is a risk of injury associated with ice skating. Persons using CCCA rinks do so at their own risk.


